Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email of 30 November 2012 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982:

 'The costs of the SuperGold Card [scheme] on public transport, broken down by region (and in some cases by route). I wanted to compare the last year with the first or second year of the discounts.'

This information is provided in Attachment 1. You will note the table provides two columns of figures for the 2008/09 year. This is because the SuperGold Card Scheme began in October 2008. The first column shows the first nine months of 2008/09 and the other shows an estimate for a full 12-month year.

Because of the way information is reported to the NZ Transport Agency (NZTA) it is not possible to provide costs by route.

Funding for the Waiheke Island ferry (operated by Fullers) has been capped since November 2010 at \$1,500,000 (excluding GST). It is adjusted annually in line with consumer price index increases (\$1,540,500 in 2011/12 and \$1,559,000 in 2012/13).

As Andy Knackstedt noted in his email of 3 December 2012, the SuperGold Card free off-peak travel concession does not apply to inter-regional services such as the Overlander. It is only available on services operating within regions that were identified in the regional public transport plan before the introduction of the moratorium on new services in November 2010.
