

Application to have a motorcycle added to the Learner Approved Motorcycle Scheme prohibited list

This form is to be used when applying to have a motorcycle with an engine capacity under 250cc added to the prohibited Learner Approved Motorcycle Scheme (LAMS) list.

Before you apply for a motorcycle to be added to the prohibited list you must be aware of the following factors:

- Only motorcycles with an engine capacity under 250cc will be considered.
- All motorcycles with an engine capacity below 250cc are considered to comply unless they are on the prohibited list.
- Prohibited motorcycles must have a power-to-weight ratio exceeding 150kw per tonne.
- The NZ Transport Agency (NZTA) is not obliged to add vehicles to the prohibited list if it is not considered appropriate to do so.
- Motorcycles already on the prohibited LAMS list can be found on the Transport Agency website at www.nzta.govt.nz/lams.
