Sealing the shared path beside the expressway

The shared path that runs from Mazengarb Road to Peka Peka beside the Kāpiti Expressway is being chipsealed. The path for cyclists and pedestrians is sealed at the southern end of the expressway and this work will extend the sealing to the northern end.



Cyclists, pedestrians and horse riders:

Please be aware that sections of the shared path and the bridle path will be closed from time to time during the preparatory and sealing works. You may need to detour onto local roads to avoid worksites.

- 5. Ngarara Road to Ngā Manu Access Road
- 6. Ngā Manu Access Road to Smithfield Road
- 7. Smithfield Road to Peka Peka Road
