

# Memorial Park Underpass opens, top of Tory St closes - 29 September

The underpass beneath the National War Memorial Park opens to west-bound traffic on Monday 29 September 2014 and will replace the temporary Buckle St Diversion (State Highway 1).

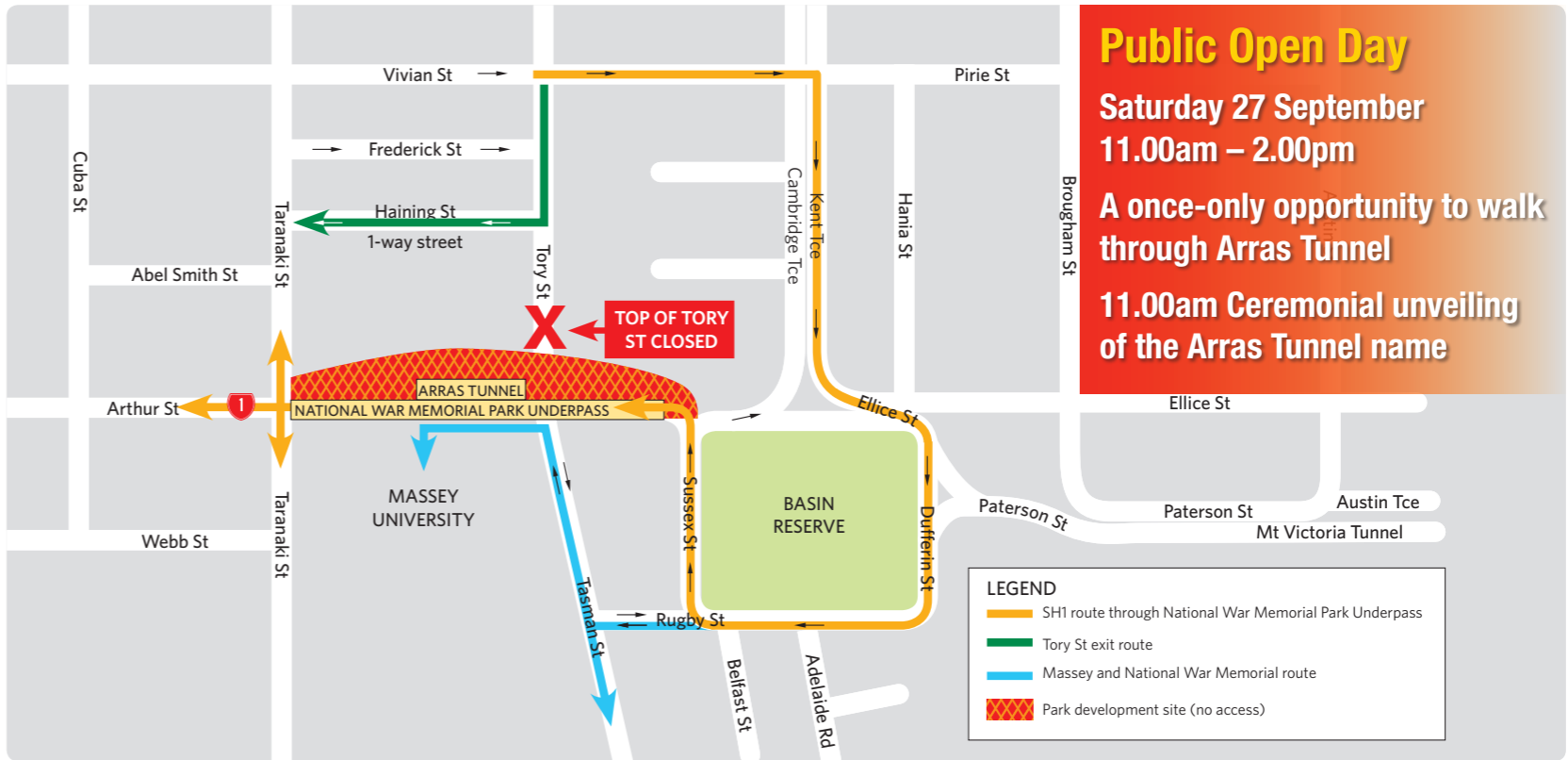
To allow progress on the construction of Memorial Park:

- The intersection at the top of Tory St will be closed to traffic.
- Access to businesses at the top end of Tory Street will be maintained.
- Tory St vehicles should access State Highway 1 via either
  - The one-way Haining St route to Taranaki St, or
  - The Vivian St/Kent Tce/Basin Reserve route.
- When the park is built, a link from Tory St to Tasman St will be reinstated.
- Pedestrian and cyclist access routes will be maintained.
