# **Picton to Christchurch alternate state highway route** (via Murchison and Lewis Pass)

The main route between Picton and Christchurch on State Highway 1 is closed due to substantial slips and road damage following the 14 November earthquake.

The alternate state highway route between Picton and Christchurch is via state highways 7, 65, 6 and 63 via Murchison and Lewis Pass.

This is likely to remain the main route for several months at least.

### SAFETY TIPS FOR DRIVING THIS ALTERNATE ROUTE

- You should expect this journey to take on average seven and a half hours. Drivers should build in extra time as delays are likely with increased traffic volumes and safety roadworks underway.
- There is currently four times the usual amount of traffic on this route, including more large trucks.
- Drivers need to slow down, be extra cautious and patient. If safe to do so, pull over to let traffic behind you pass. This will stop drivers behind you from becoming frustrated and making poor overtaking decisions.
- This alternate route is a challenging road to drive

   being narrow and windy in many places. Strictly
   adhere to all road signage and speed restrictions.

   Police patrols will be present along this route to
   enforce speed limits and to ensure the safety of all
   road users.

- Do not drive when you are tired; tired drivers are slower to react, make poor judgement decisions and find it harder to concentrate.
- Be courteous, share the road and take joint responsibility to get everyone to their destination safely this holiday season.
