



Application for Category A left-hand drive vehicle permit

This form is to be used to apply for Category A left-hand drive vehicle permit for a specified class MA vehicle that is less than 20 years old.

Important: A maximum of 500 Category A left-hand drive vehicle permits will be granted in any one year. A Category A left-hand drive vehicle must be border inspected and/or certified for entry into service in New Zealand within six months of the date of issue of a Category A left-hand drive vehicle permit.

Before you apply for a permit, you should consider the following factors:

- The matters to be considered before a permit can be granted are set out in law. This means permits are not automatically granted.
- The law does not provide for a permit to be granted on the basis of inconvenience or hardship.
- The fee is non-refundable - regardless of whether your application is granted or declined. The fee covers the cost of processing your application.
- The NZ Transport Agency (NZTA) is not obliged to grant a permit if it is not considered appropriate to do so.
- The NZTA may impose conditions to any permits issued.

Left-hand drive vehicle criteria

A left-hand drive vehicle must be owned as a collector's item (as determined by the NZTA), and:

be of historic value
(evidence of historical significance must be supplied with this application)

or

The vehicle's make, model and submodel has never been manufactured in right-hand drive form
(evidence from the manufacturer must be supplied with this application), **and**
the vehicle meets three of the following four criteria:

The vehicle is and was manufactured as a two-door coupe or convertible
(evidence must be supplied with this application)

The vehicle is and was manufactured as a high performance vehicle
(evidence must be supplied with this application)

The vehicle's make, model and sub-model has been (or was) manufactured in annual volumes of 20,000 units or less
(evidence must be supplied with this application)

The vehicle (or its make, model and sub-model is identified as being a collector's item in a commercially produced motoring publication:
(a copy of the relevant article must be supplied with this application)

Required documentation (The following items must be included in your application. Please check to ensure each one is attached.)

Proof of title (for example, overseas registration papers in the owner's name) and a documented ownership trail from the last registered owner

Proof that the vehicle meets required Category A left-hand drive vehicle criteria

Proof of New Zealand citizenship or residency

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Personal declaration *(to be completed by vehicle owner)*

I declare that:

- a) I am registering the vehicle with a Category A left-hand drive vehicle permit for my own personal use, and
- b) I will retain ownership of the vehicle for at least four years after the date the vehicle is first registered in New Zealand, and
- c) I have not been granted another Category A left-hand drive vehicle permit within the last two years, and
- d) I will not sell or lease the vehicle to a third party for at least four years after the date on which the vehicle is first registered in New Zealand, and
- e) the vehicle will be used for personal purposes and will not be used for commercial purposes, and
- f) the vehicle will not be operated in a transport service.
