**Request made under the Official Information Act 1982**

Thank you for your email of 16 June 2014 requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982, a list of the 10 pedestrian crossings nationwide with the highest number of recorded crashes in the past five years.


This information is shown in the table below. Please note:

- The table shows crashes for the five years between 2009 and 2013.
- You asked for the 10 crossings with the most crashes but I have provided you with 15 as many of the crossings had the same number of crashes.
- In some cases, no pedestrian may have been involved, for example, the crash may have been between a cycle and a motor vehicle.
- The table includes crashes in which at least one party was injured and crashes in which no parties were injured.
