Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Further to my letter of 5 November 2018, I am now able to respond to your refined request, received on 1 November 2018, under the Official Information Act 1982:

...the numbers of individuals whose P endorsements have been either suspended (under section 87D of the Land Transport Act 1998) or revoked, and whether the reason has been recorded as 'traffic' or 'criminal'.

We have interpreted your request to cover the same period as your original request. For the period 1 September 2016 to 1 September 2018, there were a total of 171 suspensions and revocations of P endorsements. This number is made up of 127 revocations and 44 suspensions (under s87D of the Land Transport Act 1998). Of the 171 total, eight were counted as both suspensions and revocations (these were instances where a p endorsement was initially suspended and then, following investigation, it was revoked).

This number is broken down below to show whether the reason for the suspension or revocation were recorded as traffic or criminal:

Total number of P endorsements revoked: 127

- Number revoked for criminal: 33
- Number revoked for traffic: 94

Total number of P endorsements suspended (s87D): 44

- Number suspended for criminal: 40
- Number suspended for traffic: 4
