**Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2022— Director approval to set speed limits
School / Kura variable speed limit—State Highway 60, Motueka, Tasman**

Thank you for your letter dated 14 December 2023, requesting Director of Land Transport approval for Waka Kotahi's Transport Services (as road controlling authority for the State highways network) to set a 30 km/h variable speed limit on State Highway 60 through Motueka, Tasman, in accordance with the Alternative Method process provided for under Clause 2.6 of the Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2022.

I am satisfied, in line with Clause 2.6(4), good reason exists for the proposed speed limit, which would run past two schools / Kura, to be set before the next relevant plan is published. I therefore approve the proposed speed limits.
