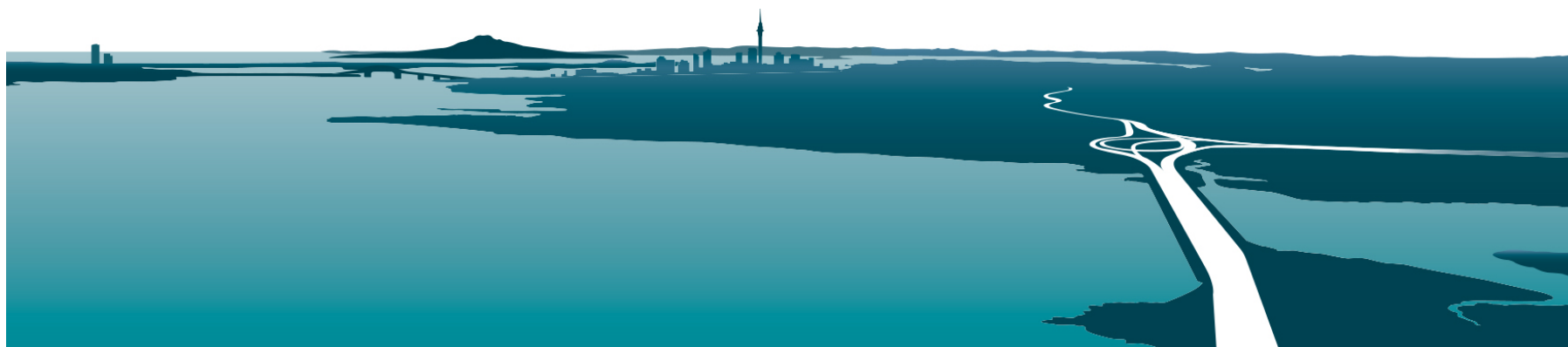

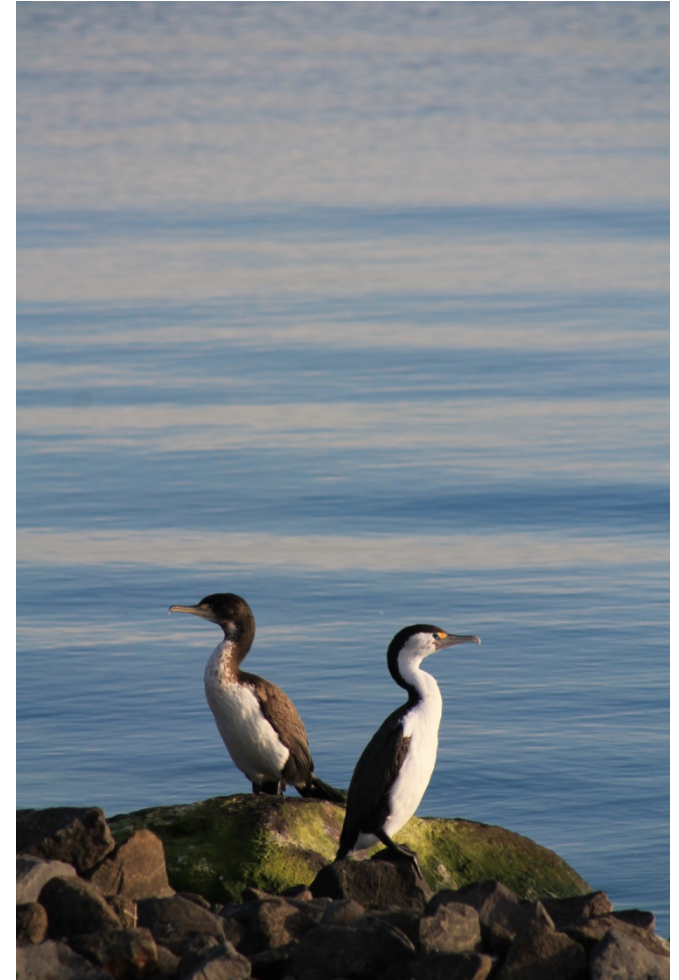

Survey feedback

Community survey

- 98% find info interesting / informative
- 90% believe works are well managed
- 90% felt motorway closures well advertised

Cycleway survey

- 81% happy with the temp cycleway surfaces
- 89% agree that works on cycleway are well managed
- 87% think that project staff are helpful and friendly

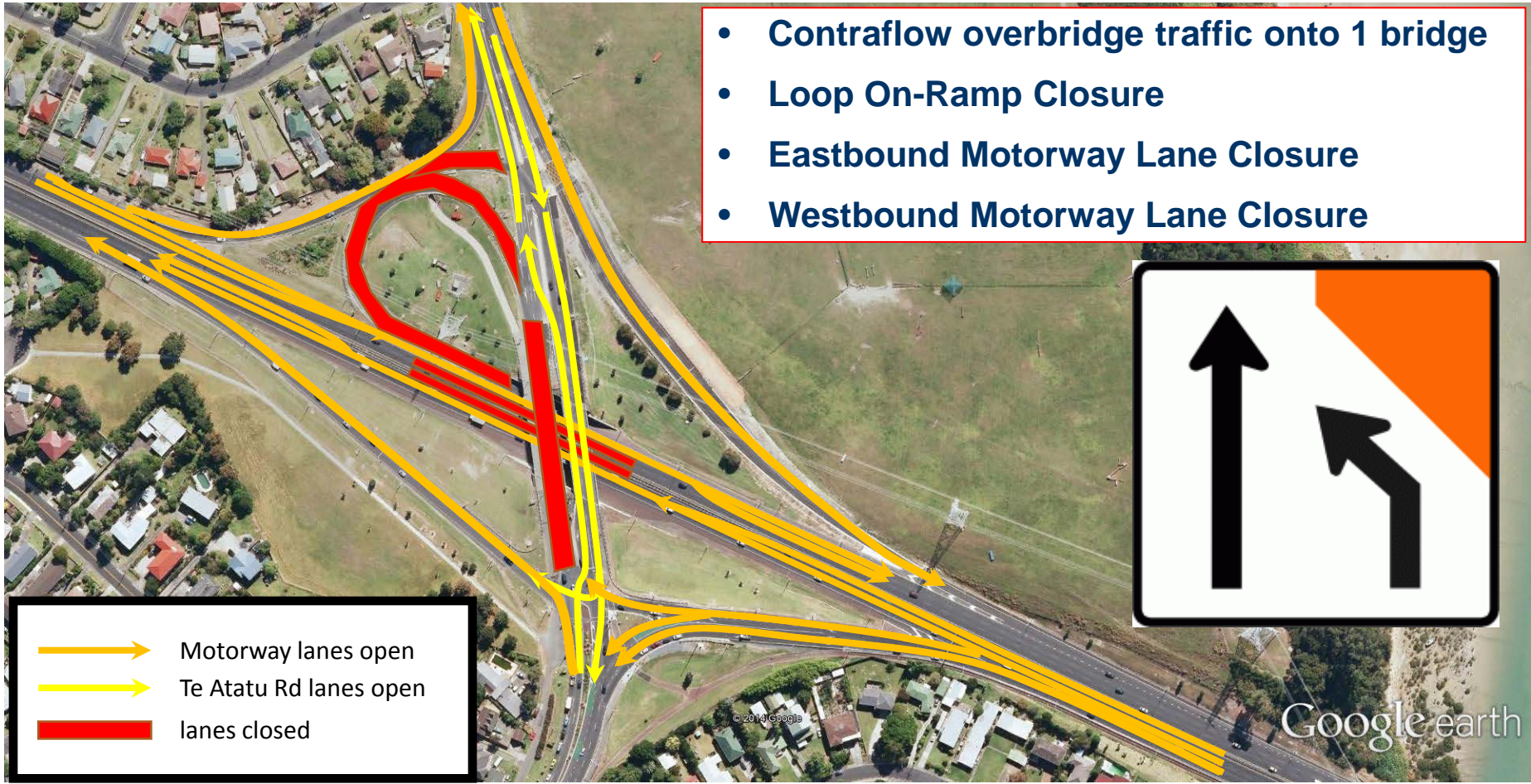

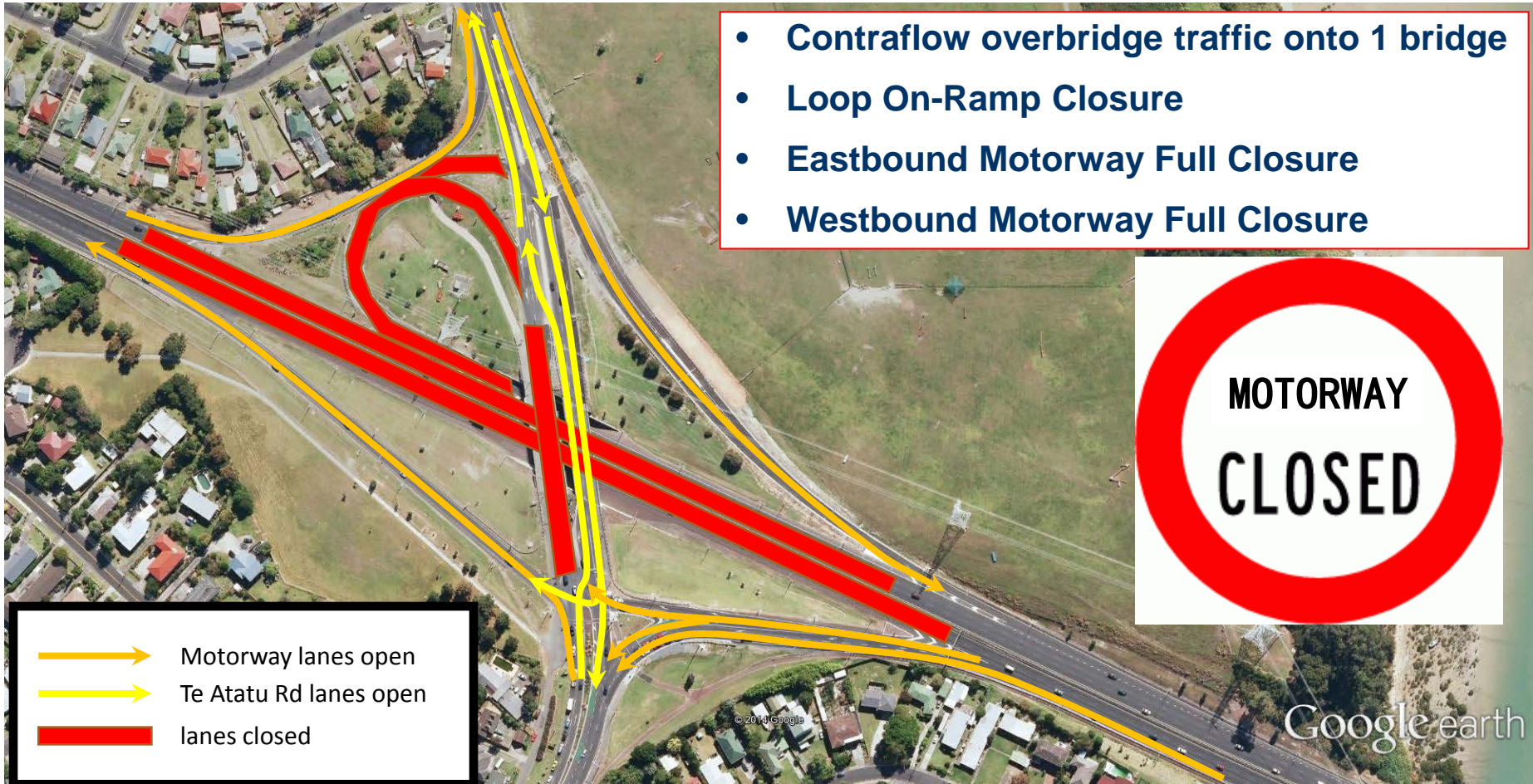

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE OPTIONS DURING TE ATATU BRIDGE ROADWORKS

OPTION ONE:

Lincoln Road, SH16, SH18, SH1

OPTION TWO:

SH16, Lincoln Road interchange, Lincoln Road, Gt North Rd

OPTION THREE:

Central Park Drive, School Road, Edmonton Road

OPTION FOUR:

SH20, Maioro Street, New Windsor Road, Tiverton Road, Wolverton Street, Clark Street, Great North Road, Lincoln Road, Lincoln Road Interchange, SH16

OPTION FIVE:

SH16, Great North Road Interchange, Great North Road, Ash Street, Rata Street, Great North Road

ROADWORKS - SECTIONS TO AVOID

SH16 between Lincoln Road Interchange and Great North Road Interchange





Things to be aware of this weekend

- Avoid travel unless necessary
- If you do travel expect significant delays at peak times
- Driver behaviour is important – follow detours and drive safely
- Traffic monitoring which can assist emergency services and adjust traffic management if required



Next bridge jacking

- Te Atatu overbridge is three separate structures requiring three weekends of closures
- Planning underway for second weekend to be between 27 Dec and 5 Jan
- Quietest for motorway network and allows all the jacking and strengthening works in one operation, reducing disruption to motorists
- Similar traffic management required
- Third weekend will be early 2015, date to be confirmed



Urban design update

- Continuing discussions with Iwi on art in design
- Art designs for underpasses and east-facing bridge balustrade is near to being finalised
- The yellow pattern colour previously shown as a draft will not be used
- Art designs will be available at the next CLG
