

Proposed traffic control device

Creation of no stopping areas on State Highway 1, Ōamaru

The NZ Transport Agency is proposing to create no stopping areas to improve safety at the following locations on State Highway 1, Ōamaru:

1. North End New World – 40 metres of no stopping south of the supermarket access.
2. Ōamaru Police Station – 10 metres of no stopping south of the southern police station access.
3. Queens Crescent & Wye Street – 125 metres of no stopping opposite these intersections.
4. Solway Street – 75 metres of no stopping opposite this intersection.

The creation of the no stopping areas was considered following discussions with the council, NZ Police and New World. They are concerned about the safety and efficiency of the network.

In making this decision, the Transport Agency considered the potential impact on the property occupiers, public and the transport system.

The maps (not to scale) show the affected areas and the extent (indicated by red line) of these proposed changes.

Once the Transport Agency has consulted on this proposal, it intends to confirm the change by making a bylaw.
