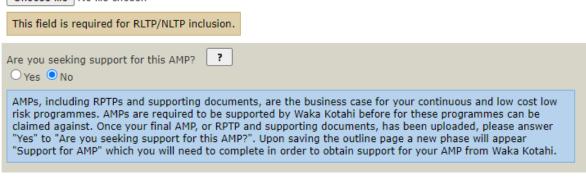

## **10 Year Forecast**

We expect the 10 year forecast in TIO to be consistent with the forecast that forms part of your long term plan and other planning documents. We expect this information to be kept as up to date as you progressively review and adopt your AMP and LTP. When the 10 year forecast is initially submitted in TIO it should reflect the level of funding and expenditure your organisation expects to receive from the NLTF to invest into subsidised activities. The 10 year forecast should also reflect the level of expenditure your organisation is looking to invest into unsubsidised activities using revenue from local sources such as rates and car parking, as well as, other crown sources (non-NLTF), like the climate emergency response fund. The 10 year forecast will need to be updated post NLTP adoption, as well as, annually by 31 August. Your Waka Kotahi investment advisor will review the forecast to ensure it is updated.
