

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

Once we have received feedback, the proposed designation boundary will be refined where required and the Indicative Alignment confirmed. A Notice of Requirement and resource consent applications will be lodged with Auckland Council in mid-2019.

2019 - STATUTORY PROCESS

Auckland Council will receive the application, directly notify people affected and notify the public via public notices in local newspapers. Council will invite people, e.g. landowners, neighbours, organisations and the wider public, to make a submission. If you make a submission you will have at least 20 working days to submit your support, opposition, or conditional support for the application. A panel of independent commissioners will be appointed to consider the application and a hearing will be held. Anyone who has lodged a submission can present their submission at the hearing if they wish to do so. Depending on the date the application is lodged, public hearings are likely to take place later in 2019. After the hearing, and once the decisions are made, there is also an opportunity for parties to lodge an appeal to the Environment Court.
