CONSTELLATION STATION UPGRADES

Upgrades will be made as part of the Northern Corridor Improvements project to Constellation Station. This is to support Auckland Transport's New Network for the North Shore.



### WHAT WE ARE DOING

#### Lengthening southbound platform

From June to September 2018, the southbound (city bound) platform will be lengthened to allow more buses to enter the station and ensure there is enough room for passengers to safely board the buses. Auckland Transport's New Network will launch after the platform has been lengthened.

## Constructing a northbound platform and footbridge to connect to the southbound platform

Work will be done from early 2019 to late 2020 to construct a new northbound platform on the other side of the station to enable more capacity. A footbridge, like at Smales Farm and Akoranga Stations, will connect the platforms.

#### **Extending the Northern Busway**

A new extension of the Northern Busway will be built from Constellation to Albany Station. The new Busway extension will span Constellation Drive with a bridge, it will then continue to run alongside SH1 to Albany, crossing into Albany Station on a new bus bridge.

#### WHAT IT WILL LOOK LIKE?

Finer details of the design are still being worked through alongside mana whenua, to tell the story of the rich history in the area.

## OTHER RELATED PROJECTS

A new Shared Use Path for cyclists and pedestrians will also run the length of the new Busway extension, providing easier access to by foot and bicycle.

A new station is also planned to be built on the new Busway extension at Rosedale over the next few years, providing travellers with more choice of stations to connect to.

# NEW NETWORK FOR THE NORTH SHORE
