WORK AT THE QEII DRIVE/GRIMSEYS ROAD INTERSECTION

The Christchurch Northern Corridor (CNC) Alliance team is returning to the QEII Drive and Grimseys Road intersection to do the final work. We will be milling and paving the intersection and the north west side of the interchange.

The work is planned for a week from Monday 5 October 6am through to Sunday 11 October 7pm.

Work is happening during the day. We have been waiting on the chip seal to weather before we can do the asphalt.

Nearby residents will hear the noise from the milling and paving machines.

TRAFFIC IMPACT

Grimseys Road will be closed at the QEII Drive intersection, there is no left turn in or out from Monday 5 October till Sunday 11 October.

Eastbound traffic on QEII Drive will shift lanes near the QEII Drive Bridge.

A diversion for Grimseys Road will be in place via Daniels Road, Main North Road, Hills Road and Prestons Road. See map overleaf.

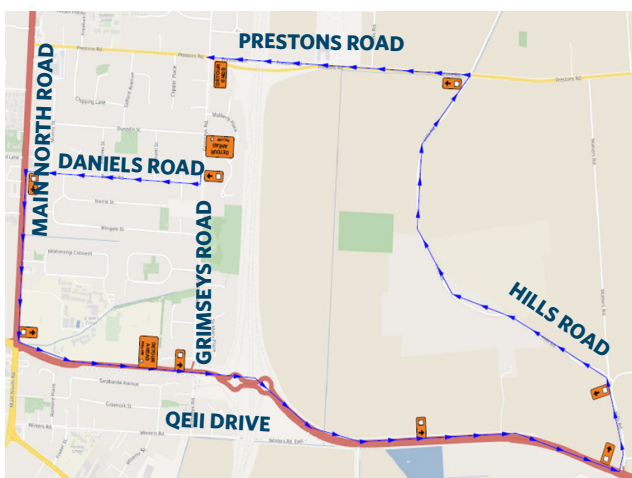
