

SH1 NORTHBOUND LANE CLOSURE

The Christchurch Northern Corridor (CNC) Alliance will be restarting construction under COVID-19 level 3 and work will continue on SH1 south of the Waimakariri Bridge. Please expect delays due to a lane closure.

We are resurfacing on SH1 between the Western Belfast Bypass and just south of the Waimakariri Bridge on the northbound lane, see map.

To do this, the right hand lane northbound will be closed, day and night from **4am Saturday 2 May till Monday 11 May. From 11 to 17 May**

the lane closure is in place only during the night.

Road surfacing work is weather dependent so this work may take longer to complete. There will be a 30km/h speed limit in place durng the work.

Chaneys on-ramp closed

During this work the Chaneys on-ramp will be closed 24/7 from 2 May till 11 May. There will be no access to the on-ramp from Main North Road and there will be no left turn from Marshland Road onto Main North Road. Straight through traffic on Main North Road is not affected.
