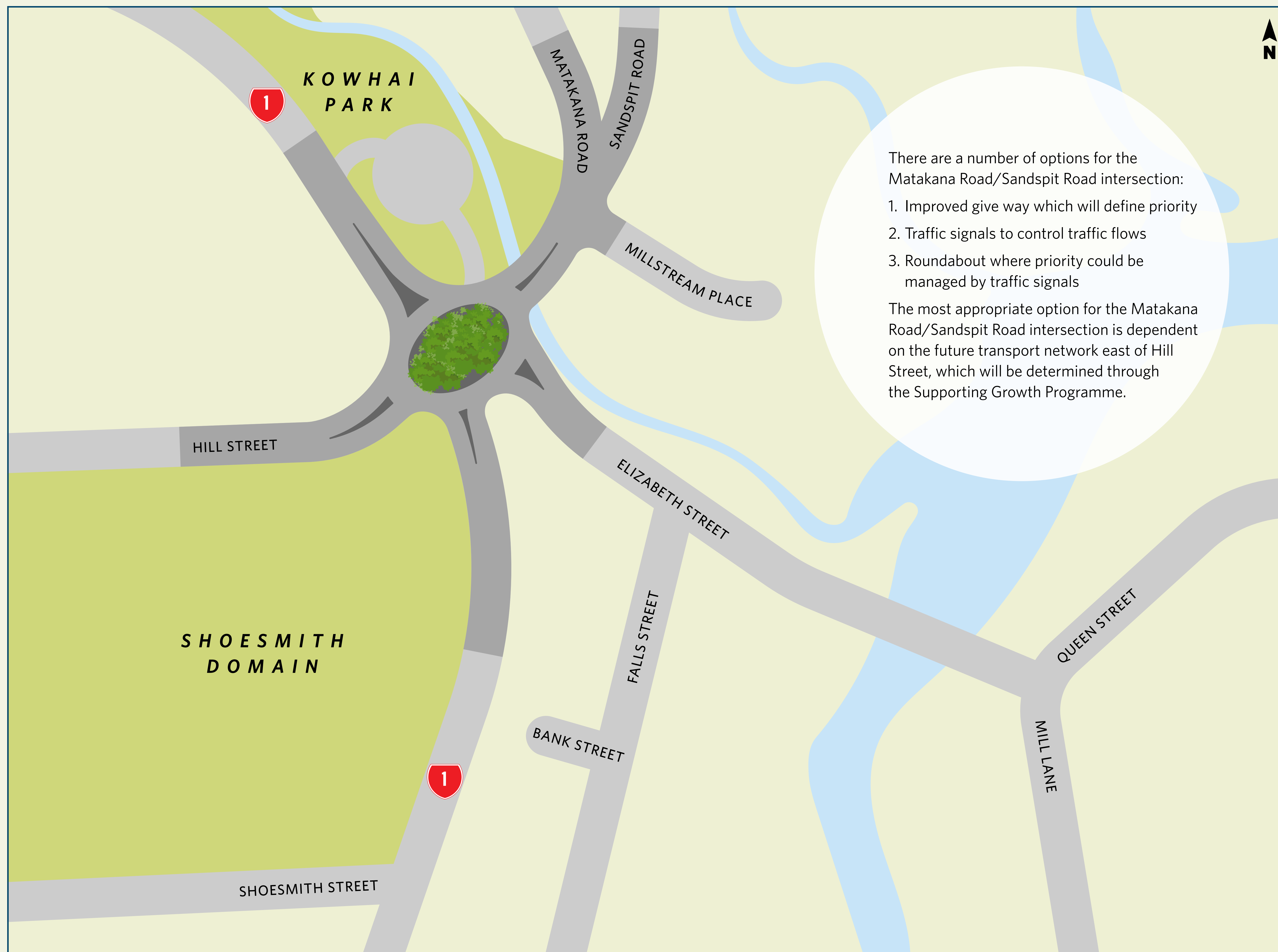


# OPTION A - ROUNDAABOUT



## KEY FEATURES

- A roundabout at the Hill Street intersection with signalised pedestrian crossing at all arms
- All movements and access points are maintained
- Traffic flows could be controlled by traffic signals
- Entry and exit to Warkworth town centre via Elizabeth Street is retained
- No impact on Kowhai Park or Shoemith Domain
- Access to Kowhai Park car park is retained

## ROUNDAABOUT

The roundabout is oval shaped to increase distance between arms, creating gaps for traffic to enter.

Roundabouts promote safer speeds and reduce vehicle conflicts as drivers always give way to their right.

## PROVIDING FOR WALKING AND CYCLING

All transport projects in Warkworth are working together to develop a safe walking and cycling network which will shape the way people travel in and around Warkworth in the future.

We will ensure that final proposals for walking and cycling on the approaches to the Hill Street intersection (as part of the Supporting Growth Programme) are aligned with our long term improvements. These will be confirmed during the next stage of the business case once a preferred option has been confirmed and therefore are not shown at this stage.
