



Upcoming works on State Highway 1 Ōpaoa River Bridge, Blenheim



Starting on May 1, for approximately four weeks, the exit onto SH1 from Dodson St will be closed to allow for new pavement construction.

We're very pleased to be back in action on the Ōpaoa River bridge. Because of the lockdown, we've had to change some of the dates that we had planned for additional traffic management.

Traffic management detours and speed restrictions will be in place along Dodson St. This traffic management will direct heavy vehicles down Hutcheson St/SH6 and light vehicles down Herbert and Budge Streets. Access to all business along Dodson St will be maintained from both approaches. An enlarged diagram showing how the closure will work can be found on the next page.

These works are weather dependent.

The new bridge over the Ōpaoa River will improve safety and journey times for all users, and we're looking forward to getting back to work on it. Please be careful, be kind, and give our crews a friendly wave when you see them.
