O Mahurangi Penlink will form a vital transport link in north Auckland as more people live and work in Silverdale, Whangaparāoa and the Hibiscus Coast.

The two-lane road with a shared path for people walking and on bikes will also provide surrounding communities with more sustainable transport choices by supporting better transport access and providing a safer journey.

O Mahurangi Penlink is part of the New Zealand Upgrade Programme, the Government's \$8.7 billion investment in growing areas across the country. Communities can look forward to transport improvements that provide more travel options, help people get where they're going safely and grow our economy, while responding to the impacts of travel on the environment.



Key features

- A new 7km transport connection between the Whangaparāoa Peninsula and SH1 at Redvale.
- A separated shared path for people walking and on bikes between Whangaparāoa Road and East Coast Road.
- South facing ramps to SH1 with an overpass over SH1.
- Local road connections at Whangaparāoa Road, Stillwater Township and East Coast Road.
- A bridge over the Wēiti River.
