<p>This wharf should not be confused with the first Puhoi Wharf that was located at Puhoi Village . The existing Puhoi Wharf and wharf shed were constructed by Rodney County in conjunction with the Marine Department in 1954. The present wharf is on the site of an earlier wooden wharf constructed by the same authorities in 1924. The 1924 Wharf was built because steamers were having difficulty accessing the Puhoi Village Wharf . When the drawbridge over the main highway was replaced by a permanent road bridge in 1924 the old Puhoi Village Wharf became inaccessible to steamers. It therefore became necessary to construct a new wharf downstream of the main road which is now known as State Highway. A small wooden wharf was then constructed beside the main north road in 1924. It was replaced in 1954. The Coastal Resources Section of ARC Environment holds a microfilm of the Plan of the 1954 Wharf (MD 9622).</p>

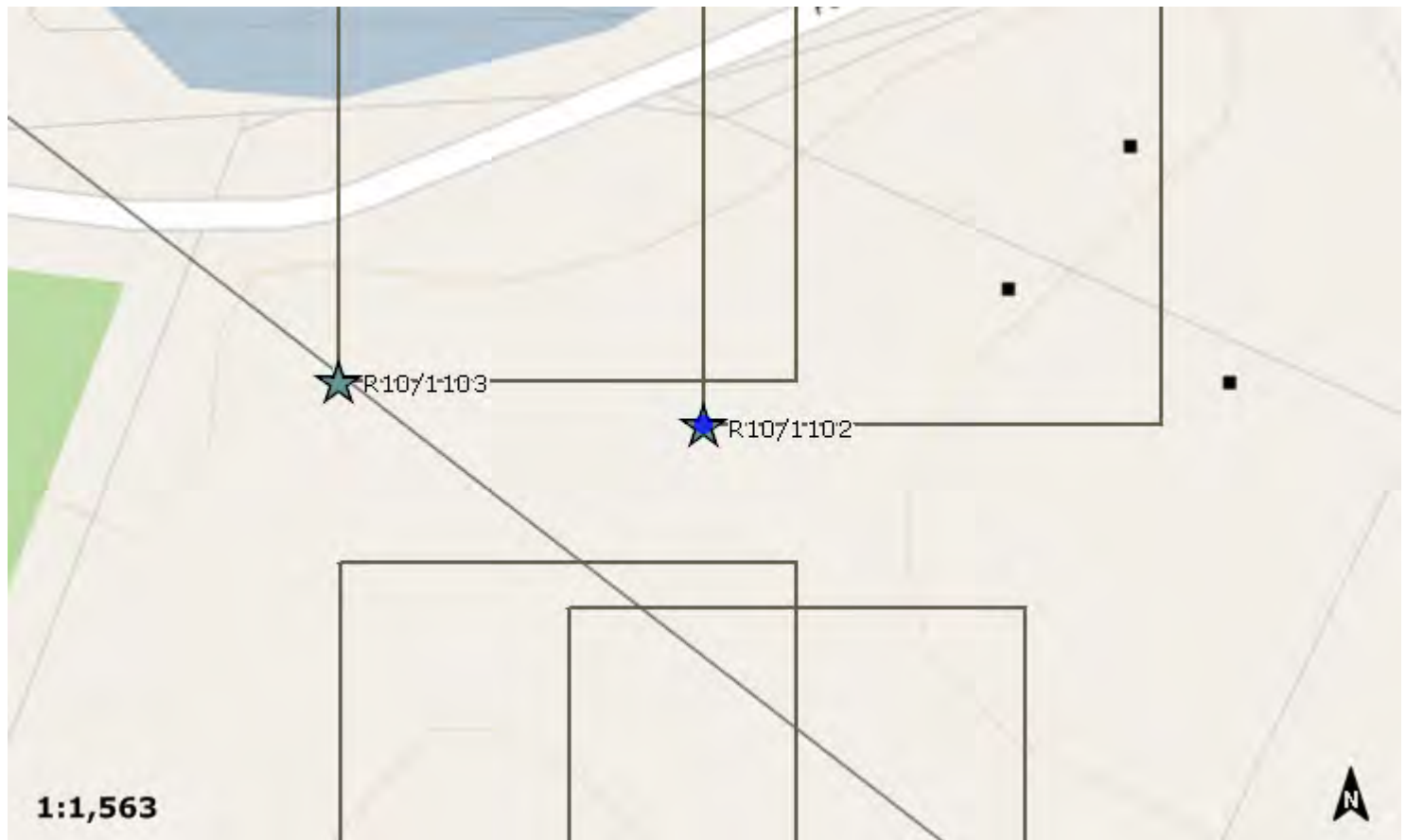

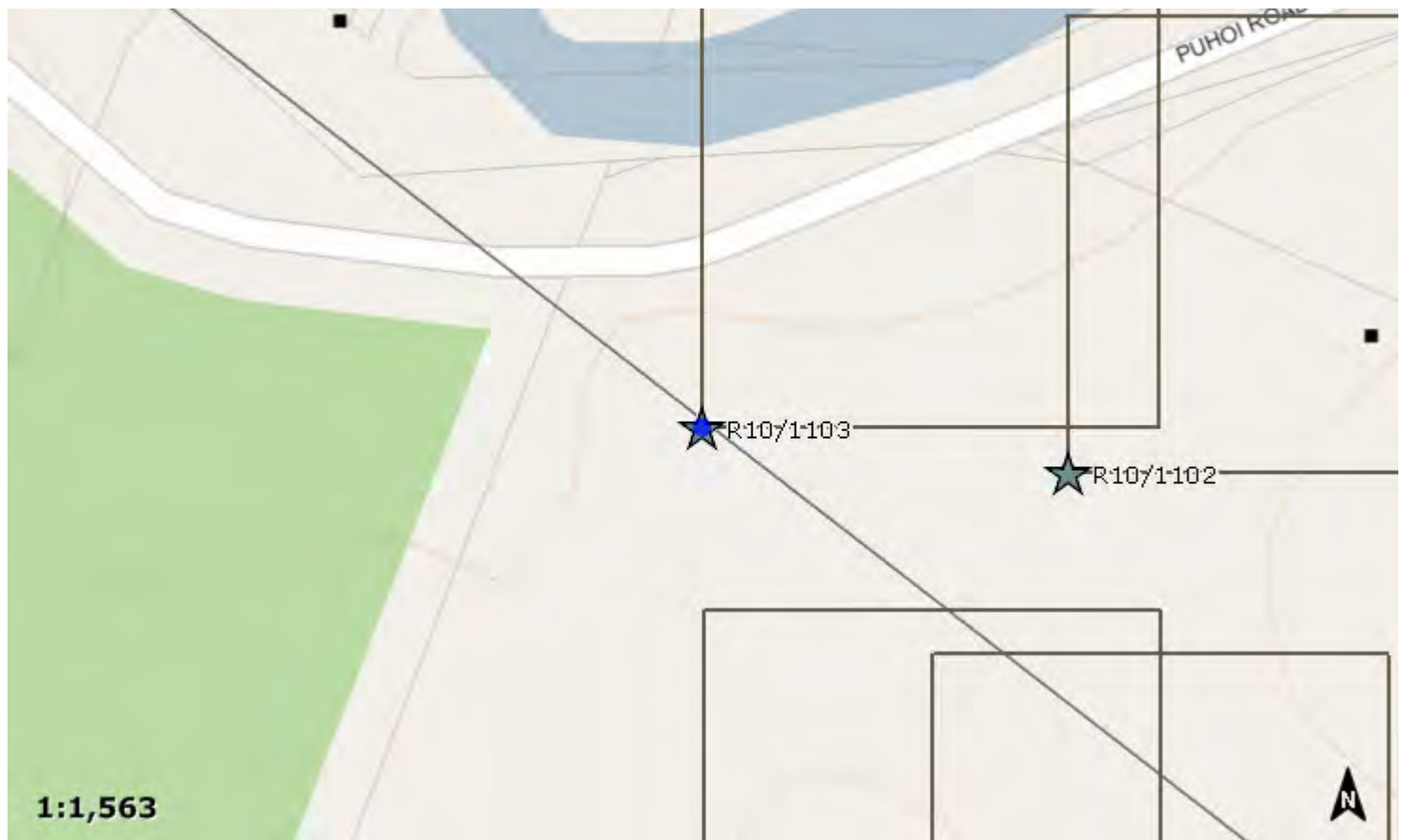
