

WORKS UPDATE 16 March 2018

Construction of the new road surface continued this week, with the completion of the base layers. This work involves digging out and backfilling soft ground areas and laying 180mm of asphalt. This work is probably the most disruptive to people who have to travel along Rocks Road. Thanks to everyone for their patience and understanding. The good news is the project is not far off being finished.

Crews have also been working on adjusting the drainage systems to the new road height, as well as repairs to the seawall and footpath.

Over the next few weeks crews will be backfilling the area behind kerbs, completing concrete works and adjusting the existing guardrail.

The final asphalt surface will not be completed until all of the additional works are done. As an interim measure a temporary centre line will be painted to guide traffic through the site until the final surface is complete. Once this is done, new road markings can be painted, including cycle lanes.
