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| 32 | NZ Heavy Haulage Association             | <p>Hello and thankyou for the opportunity to comment on this proposal.</p> <p>This feedback is provide on behalf of the numerous transport operators in the area that move wide overdimension loads along this route, who are members of this Association.</p> <p>SH16 is a main overdimension route, and we advocate that any roading changes should not restrict or make it difficult to safely transport large loads along this section of road.</p> <p>In principle we do not have an issue with the speed restriction being applied during school hours. What we are concerned about is the design and location of the new speed signs. The info provided seems to differ as to whether there is to be a single electronic speed at each location – or as it says below that are to be put on both sides of the road.</p> <p>In either situation, to enable overdimension loads up to 11m to travel, we request a width envelope of 11.5m be provided:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Between the signs, if they are on each side of the road, or</li> <li>- Between the single electronic sign, and any other roadside restriction, such as a lightpole, sign or other impediment. This applies to any opposing restriction that is 20m forwards or backwards of the electronic sign.</li> </ul> <p>If you have any queries about this request, then please do contact me.</p> |
