

Right turn bays

What is a right-turn bay?

- A right-turn bay is an area in the centre of the road where vehicles that are turning right can wait until it is safe to turn, without holding up vehicles going straight through
- Right-turn bays are not designed to overtake a vehicle travelling straight ahead
- Right-turn bays provide drivers with the opportunity to turn right into side roads without needing to go through a turning area such as a roundabout
