You will have seen quite a few things happening over the last month, we have:

- Prepared the area at Waiwhakaiho bridge and started piling for the
- Removed trees and put up a rail safety fence along SH3 between Devon Street East and Waiwaka Terrace so we can start work on the road early next year
- Started creating the piers at Te Henui bridge and undertook work on the storm water system
- Made a start on the retaining wall at Te Henui for the walkway to New Plymouth Girls High School.

Thank you for your patience, especially while we have had the shoulder closed between Devon Street East and Waiwaka Terrace.




Before you head away for your summer holidays we wanted to update you on the construction planned in early January, this includes:

- Devon Street East / SH3 road layout change 8 January 2015 (see map top right)
- Temporary part closure of Queens Road 9 January 2015 until June 2015 (see map bottom right)
- SH3 narrowing between Devon Street East and Waiwaka Terrace
 12 January 2015 until October 2015
- Night work at Mangorei Road / SH3 intersection Mid-January 2015 until April 2015
- Lane closures between Waiwaka Terrace and Mangorei Road Mid-February 2015 until May 2015
