

Takanini interchange

The Takanini interchange is being upgraded as part of the Southern Corridor Improvements Project to improve safety and traffic flow.

There are a number of known safety risks and capacity issues at the Takanini interchange being addressed as part of the Project.

The northbound loop on-ramp opened in 2019 improved capacity and merge safety for motorists joining the motorway heading north.

Additional lanes on Great South Road will improve traffic flow both through the interchange and accessing the motorway.

New pathways and crossing facilities along Great South Road will significantly improve safety for pedestrians and cyclists.
