THE OPPORTUNITY:

As an apprentice, you'll have the opportunity to learn all about heavy civil infrastructure and earthworks, and to operate heavy machinery on the Te Ahu a Turanga: Manawatū Tararua project as we build the new highway.

You'll be put through a civil infrastructure apprenticeship scheme and earn while you learn. There will be on the job training and development to keep you progressing, and your apprenticeship training advisor will be with you all the way. At the end of it you'll have completed a Civil Infrastructure Apprenticeship while gaining two New Zealand Certificates and be eligible to become Trade Certified.

ABOUT YOU:

Civil infrastructure can be tough work so you'll need to be physically fit. Ideally you'll have NCEA Level 2 and a full driver's license. You'll need a Class 2 license to operate our machinery, but we can help you to get that if you don't have it.

Great communication skills are essential. You'll be operating machinery in situations where clear

communication with your co-workers is vital to get the job done safely.

Flexibility is also important as earthworks can involve some long hours, so you'll need to be willing to put in the hard yards onsite.

A willingness to learn and understand safety rules is a must. Safety is our number one priority on this project. Most importantly, we are looking for people with great attitudes.

WHAT'S IN IT FOR YOU?

A fantastic opportunity to start a meaningful and exciting career! You'll earn a good wage and your apprenticeship training fees are fully subsidised. You'll be part of a major alliance that is building an iconic piece of infrastructure for the central north island, reconnecting east and west.
