Title and commencement-

This bylaw may be cited as the New Zealand Transport Agency (Speed Limits on State Highways) Amendment Bylaw 2011/9 and will come into force 28 days after the date of publication of this notice in the New Zealand Gazette.

Amendment-

The New Zealand Transport Agency (Speed Limits on State Highways) Bylaw 2010/10* is hereby amended by:

- Inserting new line 57A in Schedule 1 to read:

"Line No.: 57A Region: 1 SH No.: 15A

Locality: Marsden Point

Section of State Highway: From 205m south-west of Mair Road to 440m north of Mair Road.

Speed Limit (km/h): 70
