

Information sheet: PROGRAMME BUSINESS CASE: INTERVENTION HIERARCHY



This information sheet is supplementary to the online modules on the programme business case.

The NZ Transport Agency expects that an intervention hierarchy approach will be applied to all investment proposals, at both programme and project levels.

An intervention hierarchy is applicable to all steps in the planning and investment process. In practice, that means that alternative and option selection should start with lowest cost alternatives and options, including making best use of existing transport capacity, before considering higher cost alternatives and options.

Below is an example of an intervention hierarchy for National Land Transport Fund (NLTF) investments.
