Register to receive notification of changes to CoPTTM and updates on topics of interest	February 2018	<p>Major changes to CoPTTM are currently notified through the TAN system and all other changes are notified on the CoPTTM pages of the NZTA website.</p> <p>There have been numerous complaints that this approach has led to changes being made to the CoPTTM and people not being made aware of those changes.</p> <p>Because of this, NZTA has decided to operate a separate notification system for changes to the CoPTTM.</p> <p>From January 2018, changes to the CoPTTM (and items of interest to the TTM industry) will be notified to interested parties who have registered to receive CoPTTM updates.</p> <p>To register to receive CoPTTM updates, click the link below.</p> <p>CoPTTM.notify@nzta.govt.nz</p> <p>The TAN system will continue to be used to advise of major updates to the CoPTTM, whereas those subscribing to the new email address will receive more frequent reports.</p> <p>Examples of upcoming changes to CoPTTM (and items of interest) that will be notified via the new system are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Decisions on CoPTTM Consult submissions • Request to identify conflicts in the CoPTTM
