NOTES FOR SPECIFICATION FOR LITTER AND RUBBISH REMOVAL

1. GENERAL

The notes are for the guidance of supervising officers only and must not be included in the Contract documents.

The intention of the specification is to allow the Engineer to schedule those areas requiring litter and rubbish removal on a regular cyclic basis. Typical areas would include road surface, shoulders, berms and verges, medians, rest areas and landscaped areas.

The schedule should describe the limits of removal in terms of Route Position and distance from the road centre line to control and limit the cost of this maintenance operation.

2. **RESPONSE TIME**

A response time for litter removal should be specified in terms of a day in the week or month, e.g. all litter and rubbish shall be removed on the first working day of the week. It may also be necessary to specify a minimum response time for emptying rubbish bins.
