

M30 SPECIFICATION AND GUIDELINES FOR ROAD LIGHTING DESIGN

Luminaire Acceptance Process

The M30 specification references a list of luminaires accepted for installation on the State highway network. The accepted luminaires have been independently assessed against the criteria listed the M30 document. All proponents considering submission of luminaire information for M30 acceptance are advised to contact one of the above assessors prior to submission to ensure the information being submitted is complete and to the required standard.

There will be charges for the assessment work undertaken by the assessors on your behalf. All charges are the proponent's responsibility. NZTA is not able to assist you with these charges.

The approval process is as follows:

- a) Contact one of the independent assessors above, agree all contractual aspects and prepare a complete submission for assessment (refer M30 for information required or request a submission pack from the assessor).
- b) Forward information to your chosen independent assessor and address any queries or requests for further information to allow them to complete the assessment.
- c) Once your assessment is completed and all payments of independent fees have been received, the independent assessor will forward their recommendation to NZTA for confirmation of acceptance.
- d) NZTA will contact you confirming M30 acceptance for the installation of your luminaire on the State highway network. You may use this communication as proof of acceptance under the M30 specification until the List of Accepted Luminaires ([M30 accepted luminaires list](#)) on the NZTA website is updated with a listing of your product.
