

Use this form if you wish to change the gender recorded for you on the Driver Licence Register (or the Motor Vehicle Register) and your evidence of identity does not show your preferred gender.

Making a statutory declaration

A statutory declaration is a written statement declaring something to be true in the presence of an authorised witness. It is an offence to make a statement which is false for any purpose under the Land Transport Act 1998.

What needs to be in the statutory declaration?

The declaration needs to state the gender you wish to have recorded on the Driver Licence Register and the period of time you have maintained that gender.

If you also wish to amend the gender information recorded for your vehicles on the motor vehicle register, please record the plate numbers below:

Signing the declaration

This statutory declaration must be signed and dated in front of someone who has the authority to take statutory declarations and they must also sign to confirm that you have signed the declaration in front of them.

Who can be an authorised witness for a statutory declaration?

The witness for a statutory declaration must be one of the following:

- Member of Parliament
- Justice of the Peace
- Lawyer
- Registered Legal Executive (Fellow of NZILE)
- New Zealand Registered medical practitioner
- Government officer authorised to take statutory declarations

This statutory declaration can be presented, together with your evidence of identity document, as part of driver licensing transaction.

Alternatively if you are applying directly to the NZTA to amend the sex/gender information on your driver licence record, the statutory declaration, certified copies of your evidence of identity (listed in Factsheet 20) and any other required documentation should be sent to:
